## Nose Piercings Require Thorough Aftercare

It is important to understand that you need to care for the pierced area to keep it healthy and beautiful. Medical nose piercings are carried out by a doctor or nurse using medical, sterile equipment designed to virtually eliminate the chance of initial infection.



## Pause Some Regular Activities

Most people don't realize that getting your nose pierced may temporarily prevent them from doing some of their favourite activities. This is because some activities may increase the chances of developing an infection or even cause an injury when the wound is not yet healed.



## Some Nose Piercing Metals Can Cause Piercing Rejection

Piercing rejection occurs when the body does not welcome the foreign object that has been pierced into your body tissue. Although many factors may contribute to piercing rejection, a large majority of cases are due to the metals used to do the nose piercing. Some metals cause your body to want to push the piercing out of your skin, or, worse, wanting to absorb the piercing into your skin. The right nose piercing jewellery will significantly reduce the risk of piercing rejection.



## Nose Piercings Could Cause Permanent Damage

Unless the nose piercing is administered by a professional, it is extremely easy to cause permanent damage during a nose piercing procedure. Complications include:

**Nerve damage:** The piercer can inappropriately puncture the nose and hit a nerve in the process, causing permanent nerve damage.
